Panthers Football is open to elementary and middle school children ages 6 to 14 or 1st through 8th grade. Here is some important information for the 2009 football season:

REGISTRATION Panthers Football registration opens June 1st and will close July 3rd or as age groups fill. Please be certain to register early to avoid missing out! The Panthers will not be mailing registration forms this year so please visit the Panthers' website (www.panthersports.org) and click on the registration link to sign up.

FIRST GAME – LABOR DAY WEEKEND Labor Day falls on September 7th this year. As a result, the AYL, and many of the metro area leagues will begin play Saturday, September 5th. The league understands that many families schedule vacations over the last weekend of summer. However, pushing the start of the season to September 12th will result in scheduling issues late in the season, especially if we experience bad weather. Please do what you can to avoid missing that important opening day.
